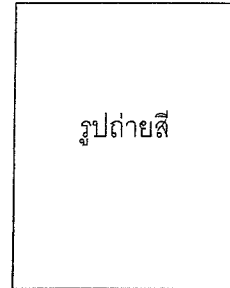

Eligibility

- Candidates must be **citizens of an ASEAN** member state (Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Indonesia, Lao PDR, Malaysia, Myanmar, The Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, or Vietnam) and must be **enrolled full-time** at a post-secondary institution in an ASEAN member state.
- Candidates must demonstrate a commitment and capacity to use their studies in Canada to help reduce poverty in the developing countries of ASEAN and to achieve the **2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development**.
- For undergraduate applications, a written **student exchange agreement** must be in place at the time of application.

Value and Duration

- CAD 10,200 for undergraduate or graduate students for one term;
- CAD 12,700 for graduate students for a period of five to six months; or
- CAD 15,900 for undergraduate students for two terms.

Dates 2020

February 26: UVic application deadline (*official deadline March 5*)

May: final selection and results

Scholarship recipients may commence their studies or research between August 1, 2020 and February 1, 2021.

4. The University of Victoria applies on behalf of the candidate(s).
